With these funds we were able to purchase 2 awnings for the school. One in the back of school and the other on the side facing McCormick Center. PC also uses funds to help the teachers with their classroom start up costs, field trips, recorders for the 3rd grade, AR and library, playground maintenance, technology (\$13,500 last year) art enrichment, school counselor, science lab as well as other areas including the annual walk to the Lincoln Theatre the last day before the Christmas break.

We received almost \$400 from the EDGE/Laser Rock fundraiser.
